Who is eligible for this course?

- Learners must either live OR work within Greater Manchester
- Learners should be employed in a care service, actively engaged as a senior care member, or have access to senior shifts
- Learners are required to be assigned an appointed mentor
- Learners should not currently possess a Level 4 Diploma in Adult Care
- Learners should ideally have a minimum of Level 2 in Literacy and Numeracy or equivalent
- Learner must be aged 16 or above
