

GPN Next Steps

- Will run 3 times each year
- 30 learners per cohort / 90 learners per year
- For GPNs and NAs who have completed the GPN Foundation
- 12 week programme of clinical learning
- New addition to current programme of Smoking Cessation which will also be open to HCAs
- There is a gap of 3 months between the Foundation and Next Steps when learners can access other aspects of the PC IDP or the N2PC but they suggested they access N2PC in year 2.



Dentistry

- Will run one programme a year
- Diabetes and Cancer (non-head and neck)
- 3 x 60-75 minute lunchtime sessions for each topic
- One Topic October to December



N2PC (New To Primary Care)




- 100 learners per cohort / 100 learners per year
